Last meeting

Many thanks to Joe Debatista from Queensland Health for coming along to talk about sexual health issues. Joe was quick to point out that regardless of sexual orientation, sexual health issues are very similar.

Joe's says that as parents, we need to be aware of and encourage safe sexual practice. Some of Joe's tips are:

- ★ condoms should ALWAYS be used
- ★ be vaccinated against Hepatitis A and B
- ★ have regular sexual health check ups

Joe recommends that when a new relationship is starting, the couple get a sexual health check-up, with the possibility of a condom not being used only when the relationship is monogamous.

This eliminates the risk of passing on any infection from past relationships, and keeps both people safe. Joe also removed much of the "fear factor" for many of the parents regarding HIV. A big "thank you" to Joe for giving up his Saturday afternoon!

Parents Struggling with Religious Issues

I was recently reading a book called "Is the Homosexual My Neighbour?". It's a Christian positive response written by Scanzoni and Mollenkot.

I have no intention of starting a debate about religion (as PFLAG is non-religious), but I have spoken to a few struggling parents recently, and these few sentences may provide some comfort or at least something to think about...

- True self-acceptance comes most readily from the realization that God loves and accepts us just as we are.
- Condemnation is, indeed a boomerang. Fortunately, so is loving.
- Jesus knew all about stigma. He never hesitated to move among the oppressed people of his day, including the most despised social outcasts.

A number of meetings ago, guest speaker Catholic priest Father John was asked about the dilemma of religion & having a lesbian daughter or gay son. He stated "if you have to choose between church and child, choose your son or daughter".

Goals for 2008

Our goal in 2006 was to support rural families and youth. We believe this was very successful, thanks to our Long Reach for Out Reach Project and resource packs (www.longreachforoutreach.org).

In 2007, we hosted the 3rd National PFLAG Conference (in June), and we continued lobbying for an end to economic discrimination for same sex couples on a Federal level.

Website Update

In October, the PFLAG Brisbane website received 782 unique visitors (compared with 718 in September, and 1112 in August).

The most popular hour of the day for visits was 8am in October, and 9pm in September. Our busiest day online in October was the 1st, and our busiest day online in September was the 14th.

In October, Shelley's eBook "Sexuality is not a choice" was downloaded / read 900 times (compared with 888 times in September).

In October, visitors came from Australia (most popular) followed by the USA, Ireland, and then Canada. In September, Australia was at the top of the list once more, followed by the USA, Ireland, New Zealand and China. Out of Australian locations, Brisbane was the most popular, followed by Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide, Perth, Ballarat, Toowoomba, Canberra and then Hobart.

Each conference speech (recordings of speeches from our many guest speakers at the June 2007 Conference) has been downloaded about 15 times each month, in October & September.
