LGBTIQ Community Summit

Activating Human Rights & Peace Conference

1st - 4th July, Byron Bay

As part of this international conference, PFLAG Brisbane convener *Shelley Argent* presented a paper and took part in a panel which discussed LGBTIQ rights. Shelley spoke about being a parent and watching the Federal Government actively discriminate against one son (just because of his sexuality) while his heterosexual brother is able to take his rights for granted.

Stonewall Celebration

For those who may be unaware, 'Stonewall' was the human rights march that took place 30 years ago, which began the "fight" for equality for the gay community. It was as a result of this march, that some parents of lesbian & gay children started PFLAG in the United States.

As part of the Stonewall celebration, the Metropolitan Community Chapel (MCC) asked Shelley to speak at one of their Sunday evening services. After a little initial hesitation, Shelley accepted when she was informed that the topic would be "Jesus didn't discriminate, so why should we?".

Shelley mentioned that she recalled seeing a group marching with this slogan on their shirts at the Mardi Gras parade in Sydney recently, and thought "How true is this - and where is George Pell when you want him?".

Radio 792/ABC Western Queensland

Recently, PFLAG Brisbane was contacted by a producer of "Life Matters", a program on ABC Radio

792 at 9am on weekdays. A friend of the producer has had a son/daughter "come out" and she's seen how the mother is struggling. The producer rightly assumed that there must be many others in society all having the same concerns and fears, and decided it was a good time to do a story on how many parents struggle with coming to terms with a loved one's sexual diversity.

In other news, ABC Radio in Western Queensland contacted Shelley for an interview to be aired during a 9.15am timeslot; virtually prime time morning radio.

The interview covered similar ideas about the issues for those in country areas who may be coming to terms with their own or loved one "coming out". It's heartening that the topic is being discussed and no longer swept under the rug as it used to be.
