The Surrogacy Bill 2009 debate captured much of our attention and energy.

I was welcomed by Neighbourhood Watch Annerley Branch at Buranda for yet another moment of sharing

the role of PFLAG in the community – resource material and the function of the group was well received. I shared the day with Monica O'Mara, State Coordinator for LGBTI Police Liaison Officers, Linda Petrie representing the Transgender community and the local Council member – I stepped up to the plate with this one as Shelley was on holiday in Vietnam.

Another event was an open day welcoming parents of gay children held by Open Doors – yet again opportunity to network with professionals who attended the bbq and shared their experience together with meeting with the parents who were there in support of their child.

Shelley’s Report - Parental Recognition and Surrogacy Legislation

How exciting our gay sons can now legally become fathers. Plus our daughters in same sex relationships with partners who have had IVF are now to be recognised officially as a parent, in the relationship, by Queensland and Federal Law.

This is thanks to the legislation passed mid February in Queensland Parliament.

As a parent of a gay male I remember the discussion with my son many years ago about how he could never become a father because of the legal repercussions. Now parents of sons need never have this conversation, because it is possible. This legislation also addresses the issue for many parents who grieve that they will never become grand-parents.

This legislation also provides our sons and daughters who aren’t the birth parents with emotional and financial security. It also removes the issue of next of kin for the child which assists in added security for the child and second parent, should the birth parent die or become incapacitated and unable to care for the child.

I believe the legislation will permit a back date of 5 years for couples who have had babies by IVF or other artificial reproductive treatments to place their names on their children’s birth certificates and be seen as family units. Unfortunately, this legislation doesn’t address the issue of adoption but it is still a huge step forward for our sons and daughters living in Queensland.

It is important to be aware that PFLAG has sent thank you letters to all Members of Parliament who voted in favour of this legislation.

We also sent flowers to Anna Bligh and Cameron Dick the Attorney General. The committee felt it important that we acknowledge this milestone.

I would also like to thank all of the parents who wrote and called their Members of Parliament reminding them of the need for change. Your letters and efforts went a long way to changing minds on which way to vote.
