As a result of the screening of Australian Story featuring the Argent family and their two sons and Shelley's passion to strive for equality in all areas for her gay son, gave rise to many new faces at our last general meeting.

It is hoped that the care and support of PFLAG volunteers help to provide knowledge and increased understanding for their loved ones. An attendee indicated it would be a good idea for PFLAG to speak at some of the senior venues.

There has been less travel and speaking engagements for the second part of the year, though the most recent mail out to all high schools in Queensland was a mammoth task. This comprised of 48 Tips on Anti-Bullying Practices brochures, 3 'So Gay' posters and a letter to the Administrator - distributed to 498 schools.
