#### **Marriage Equality**

This will be one of our main focuses this year. As National Spokesperson, Shelley went to Canberra in February to meet with several Members of Parliament. Shelley had two other parents (Lorraine from Gympie and Geoff from Sydney) with her, passing on the message that, as parents, we want equality for our lesbian daughters and gay sons.

Shelley was also in Sydney and Melbourne in February doing workshops for those in the gay community who want to be part of making change regarding marriage equality but don't know where to start. She was part of a team, including Rodney and Alex from Australia Marriage Equality (AME) passing on ideas and hopefully motivating people to stand up and be counted. This is so important.

Statistics are showing that approximately 80% of Australians are either in favour of, or don't care if marriage equality should occur in this country. But Christian and family lobby groups are of course very active in trying to prevent equality. So it's very important that parents become involved and make contact with their MPs either by mail or phone.

### **PFLAG Website**

Over the past few years, the way in which many people are contacting PFLAG has changed. The stats from our website show that the site receives over 3000 direct hits per month. Booklets are also being downloaded at a great rate. As an example, the booklet "Sexuality is not a Choice," in English, has been downloaded approx 400 times per month and this booklet (in various other languages), up to 600 times per month.

Another positive is that the meetings are growing, but the issues are less intense than they were 10 years ago. Parents still have issues of shame, blame and guilt but many are now more concerned about the welfare of their son or daughter. This shows me that we are an effective organization. People are seeking information to help them understand.
