# Now on with what has been happening.

## Pride Fair Day:

This was a fun day held at New Farm Park with lots of colour and rainbows. Thanks to Debbie, Jenny, Pasi and Antoneta for their time on the stall talking to people and providing information about what PFLAG does while handing out resources.

This is a day for parents to enjoy a day in the LGBTIQQ world listening to music, getting information from stalls and talking with other parents who come along to say hello.

To me what seems most lovely is/are the young people who come along to chat with us. Many just want to say thank you to PFLAG for being there for them and loved ones during their "coming out" process.

## School Safety Project:

Janet Berry organised a special event with Daniel Witthaus as the guest speaker. The event was held at Milton where those on the Safe School Committee and others interested, came to listen to Daniel discuss homophobia in schools and what other States are doing. Plus he discussed his program that is used in schools called Pride and Prejudice.

Daniel is very knowledgeable about this topic. A couple of years ago he drove around Australia speaking with random people about homophobic attitudes. We all thought he was a little crazy, but the outcome was a pleasant surprise.

# Marriage Equality:

As National Spokesperson, this is an issue that is keeping me very busy. In the last 2 months I have been travelling with Rodney Croome from Australia Marriage Equality doing workshops and speaking at public events encouraging the general community to make contact with their Federal MP's to make it clear they are in favour of marriage equality. We have been to Geelong twice, the Gold Coast and Melbourne speaking to the community, doing workshops and holding stalls in areas where Members of Parliament are undecided about the issue. I have also been to Canberra twice since the last meeting talking to MP's in Parliament House.

We need you as parents to also speak to your MP about the need for marriage equality.

So far we are hearing that most of their constituents aren't in favour of equality, but we know this isn't correct from all of the polls, which are showing that the vast majority of Australians do want equality, but MP's aren't willing to make a stand.

This is where you can make a difference.

Your silence may ensure the discrimination continues and none of us want our children to suffer. If you want more information please check out the Crosby Textor Poll taken in July 2014 and/or go to our website pflagbrisbane.org.au for more information and then make contact with your Federal MP and tell him/her you want marriage equality for your son or daughter.

### **Updating Resources:**

As most would know we received a grant of over \$30,000 to update our resources. We are on the way to updating now. As completed they will be added to our website and then sent to the printer.

As we have been updating I realise just how times have changed not only for our sons and daughters "coming out" but how parental attitudes have changed in so many ways in the last 10-15 years when some were written.

It is no longer the extent of shame, blame and guilt. There is still shock and lack of understanding why, **BUT** so many are quickly moving to "how do I support him/her?" and "where can they find a social group for him/her" which I think is just fantastic.

Plus, young people seem to be "coming out" to family so much earlier. It is now generally 17 not 27 which lessens many of the negative impacts that many have suffered in the past due to keeping secrets and for some living a double life for too long.

Who is interested in going to Sydney next year to be part of the PFLAG family who march? Or perhaps, you may prefer to watch. This is always fun and makes everyone feel valued and appreciated. As a mum I feel it really is quite special to be part of our LGBTIQ sons and daughters one day of celebration of who they are.
