Fiona is the current President of *AusPATH*, an organisation whose primary aim is to promote the health of trans, gender diverse and non-binary people. AusPATH, or the Australian Professional Association for Trans Health, is Australia's peak body for professionals involved in the health, rights and well-being of trans, gender diverse and non-binary people. One of the organisation's goals is to create a comprehensive network and database of gender affirming GPs throughout in Australia. Additionally, Fiona introduced PFLAG members to *Equinox* based out of the University of Melbourne. This organisation hopes to create national guidelines for consistent treatment of transitioning, gender-diverse and non-binary **adults** through the medical process. Through the training of current GPs, and the introduction of these national guidelines into the Australian medical university curriculum, we hope to see more gender affirming doctors throughout Australia in the future. 


