

Some sporting codes travelled to Canberra to sign up to a policy that supports minimising homophobia both on and off of the field. But some have done very little to actually further the campaign. Homophobia like racism needs to be named and not condoned.




Safe School Policy

We are very thankful to the new Qld Government that a Safe School Policy is about to be introduced into State Schools.

This will ensure that our LGBTI children will be safe while being educated.

This policy will be especially beneficial to trans* students because it lays out guidelines explaining the dress code, name, which toilet etc.

If your child goes to a private school, the Education Department cannot enforce this policy. So my suggestion is if your child is being treated unfairly, meet with the Principal to discuss what can be done, and if that doesn't work consider taking a lawyer (or a letter from a lawyer) to outline legalities to the school.
