During our last Community meeting on the 3rd of August, we were fortunate to have National PFLAG Spokesperson, Shelley Argent, share her story with us. Shelley's new book, *Just a Mum*, outlines the story of her son coming out as homosexual in Brisbane during the mid-90s. The book follows Shelley's journey from motherhood to becoming a nation-wide LGBTIO+ activist.

Shelley will be sharing the PFLAG Brisbane booth at the upcoming Brisbane Pride Fair on the 21st of September at New Farm Park. Please stop by the booth and introduce or reintroduce yourselves to her. It is also an opportunity to pick up a copy of her new book for \$25.

Recent PFLAG Participation

Rally in Queen's Garden, Brisbane and March in CBD

On Saturday 17th of August, the LGBTIQ+ community came together for a rally against the proposed bill based on the Religious Freedom Review. The proposed legislation will allow religious exemptions to allow for discrimination against LGBTIQ+ children in schools and adults in the workplace.

Shelley Argent spoke to the rally participants, and requested that all PFLAG members, LGBTIQ+ people and allies write a letter to the PM and their local MP expressing grave concern over this proposal to allow discrimination in the name of "religious freedom".
