Indigenous PFLAG Pack

The Indigenous PFLAG Pack is now complete and ready to go to the printers. The pack consists of the section from "Sexuality is not a Choice" relating to lesbian and gays; a brochure in very simple English; and two postcards.

One postcard depicts a traditional male elder sitting in his boat with a turtle. The other picture is of a female police officer. The cards say "I am a part of your community and I am gay/lesbian". The packs have been prepared in coordination with the Two Spirits Program which is part of the Queensland Association for Healthy Communities Indigenous Program.

We believe this is the first time any support like this has been offered to indigenous families.

State Election 2009

As 2009 is Queensland state election year, PFLAG, along with other LGBT groups, will be busy lobbying Ms Bligh and Mr Springborg about the need for equality for same sex attracted couples.

The issues to be targeted are same sex recognition, adoption of partner's children and anti homophobia policies for schools.

We have a series of sample letters that you can download, which aim to send a clear message that we want equality for our sons and daughters. All you need to do is print, complete and send the letter to the desired politician(s).

We have already contacted all State politicians regarding the need for equality, but we're sure the more letters they receive, the quicker they will respond and make changes. We will also be placing a series of advertisements in the Courier Mail on a regular basis, outlining the need for change.

These advertisements are to be paid for by private donations, and not PFLAG funds - so if you would like to help, please let us know. The more funding we receive, the more advertisements we will be able to do to get the message out to our politicians and the general public.

Parents of Transgender and Intersex Meeting

The first meeting for parents of transgender and intersex was held on the 7th February. The meeting was relatively small with 4 families attending.

Dr. Gail Bearman from the Gender Clinic came along to answer questions that parents had regarding treatments. The meeting was informal with lots of conversation and comparing of situations. The next meeting will be held on Saturday the 16th of May, 2009

This was the first time that parents had been able to sit freely and talk about their personal concerns and fears with other parents in similar situations. They left knowing that they weren't alone and much more informed generally thanks to Gail. We will hold these meetings every 3 months.
