LGBT Youth Study

Many thanks to Angela Dwyer, a Lecturer in Social Justice at QUT, for coming along to give us a briefing on the outcome of a study that PFLAG subsidized late last year.

The study was about policing issues and LGBT youth at risk. The findings weren't surprising, but can now be used as a tool to encourage police to be more understanding and sensitive regarding the issues these young people have to deal with on a daily basis.

Angela is keen to see a difference is made for this marginalised group in a minority community. We wish her well with this project.

Previous Meeting

Our meeting was very well attended with several new families attending and a few of the "older" faces coming along. It was heart warming to see one particular new family who attended. We had met their son earlier in the year and he was most concerned about his families reaction because of their culture.

It was inspiring to see the love and support this young man received from his parents. If only all families could be this accepting we wouldn't need PFLAG.

Indigenous PFLAG Pack

These packs are now complete and in the process of being distributed to various groups throughout Queensland and Northern New South Wales. They have been produced in collaboration with the Indigenous section of QAHC called Two Spirits. The pack consists of a booklet, brochure and cards. A CD will be produced later in the year.

We believe this is the first time any support like this has been offered to indigenous families, and are very excited about the project, as it's something we have wanted to do for a number of years.

International PFLAG Groups

We have had some contact with PFLAG Canada and PFLAG USA recently, with an aim to swapping ideas and resources. which is helpful to all concerned. It seems regardless of the country we live in, we all have similar issues and it is our hope to be able to use some of their ideas here in Queensland.

Political Issues

We would never encourage families to vote for any particular political party, but PFLAG Brisbane Convener Shelley was particularly pleased to see the Labor Party returned to government. This means that we can now continue where we left off prior to the call of the election. If the election had gone the other way we would have had to start at the beginning again!

4BH and read the many quarter-page adverts we placed in the Courier Mail over the last 7 weeks. We think the politicians now know we mean business and want equality for our sons and daughters!
